

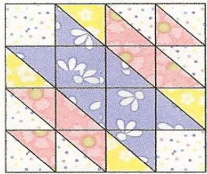
# Peace by Piecing Quilt Guild

I am making one block each month for myself in a certain colorway for my own quilt and making one in a scrappy colorway just keep the background light or white for the Lottery Block. ### Mrs. Taft's Choice



Finished Size: 9"  
Make 1

### Materials and Cutting:

7" square Pink, cut:

(4)  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares

4" x 7" rectangle Yellow, cut:

(2)  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares

7" square Lavender, cut:

(3)  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares

(2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

7" square Light Background, cut:

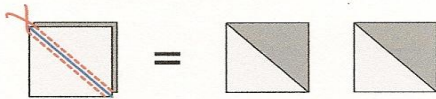
(3)  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares

(2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

Refer to drawings for placement of pieces.

### To make Half-Square Triangles (HST)

- Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of a  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " square.
- Layer together with another  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " square, right sides facing.
- Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of drawn line.
- Cut apart on drawn line.



### Block Assembly

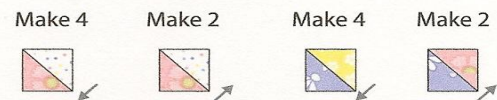
- Using 3 squares of each color, make 6 Pink/Light Background HST.
  - Press four seam allowances toward the Pink.
  - Press two seam allowances toward the Light Background to use in corners.

Using 2 squares of each color, make 4 Lavender/Yellow HST.

- Press the seam allowances toward the Lavender.

Using 1 square of each color, make 2 Lavender/Pink HST.

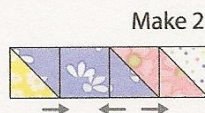
- Press the seam allowances toward the Pink.



- Sew two rows in this order:
  - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Light Background square
  - Lavender/Yellow HST
  - (2) Pink/Background HST



- Sew two rows in this order:
  - Lavender/Yellow HST
  - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Lavender square
  - Lavender/Pink HST
  - Pink/Background HST



- Sew Step 2 and Step 3 rows together. Press so seam allowances will nest together at intersections.
